> Historic show flat

On the first floor of a building rebuilt by Auguste Perret, this flat will allow you to discover the fittings which revolutionized the art of housing in the 1950's. Furniture, fabrics, lights and ceramics bring you back to the day-to-day life of that time. Dramatized tours and various activities take place on certain dates and under certain conditions.

> Ship owner's mansion

The ship owner's mansion is one of the few historic buildings situated in the city centre, the inside layout is unique: everything is organized around a central octagonal well of light. Throughout the rooms, you can discover some objects reminding the life in Le Havre between 1750 and 1870: furniture, engravings, peculiar items, old ship models...

> Malraux Museum

The Malraux Museum was recently renovated by Laurent Baudouin, it shelters the first impressionist collection of France outside Paris. Opened up on to the sea and flooded with light, it also provides a large panorama on Painting from the 17th to the 20th century, including major impressionist and fauvist works; these collections were enriched in 2005 thanks to the Senn-Foulds donation.

> **Museum of Natural History**

Installed in the former Court rooms from the 18th century, this museum was renovated not long ago. It holds collections of palaeontology and zoology, and since autumn 2007, it displays an exceptional and prestigious collection of 8000 drawings and manuscripts of the naturalist painter Charles Alexandre Lesueur (1778-1846). This naturalist artist born in Le Havre travelled around France and to "the southern lands". His works leave us with examples going back to the 19th century.

> **Graville Priory**

Reopening Spring 2008.

This Priory overlooking the Seine estuary between Le Havre and Harfleur, holds an important collection of holy art from the 16th century to our days.

It also holds a collection of models of the late 19th century and the beginning of the 20th relative to human housing. Its abbey church is listed "historic monument". The Priory is currently being re-fitted but its gardens remain open to the public.

> **Le Volcan**

"Le Volcan" is a cultural area and "national stage"; it is a major work of the Brazilian architect Oscar Niemeyer, conceived in 1982. It has two buildings with curved and pure lines, inside which you can find theatres, a cinema and a café-gig bar.

Holy Monuments

> Saint-Joseph Church

Completed in 1957 and designed by Auguste Perret, its massive tower reaches 110 metres. Outstanding well of light made of numerous stained glass windows. Figurehead of the rebuilt city, it is one of the architectural masterpieces of the 20th century.
